Duties and Responsibilities:

- Transporting visitors following a pre-planned route to a definite time schedule;
- Regulating heating equipment and ventilation of bus for comfort of passengers;
- Driving bus carefully and in compliance with National Roads traffic Acts and regulations;
- Assuming responsibility for the safety of visitors in loading, unloading and transporting them to and from various sites;
- Conducting vehicle inspection;
- Checking water, fuel, oil an mechanical condition before leaving on run;
- Keeping operational records and makes simple reports;
- Reporting defects or problems with vehicle to the unit manager;
- Adhering to maintenance schedules instructions;
- Reporting delays or accidents;
- Assist passengers, such as elderly or disabled individuals, on and off bus, ensure they are seated properly;
- Keeping passengers clued-up of likely delays;
- Check wheel ramps all the time to help disabled customers as and when required.
