Robben Island Museum commences its off peak tour schedule in mid April, with new fares from June.

With the change of season, Robben Island Museum will be changing the frequency of its daily tours, from the usual four during peak season to three for the off peak season which starts from the middle of April.

The museum will also be increasing its tariffs from June 1, 2015. This includes fares to Robben Island which will increase from the current R280 for adults to R300. Children under 18 will now pay R160. The cancellation fee for tickets cancelled 14 days prior to a tour remains R50 per ticket.

The Nelson Mandela Gateway will still operate from 7.30am to 6pm as per usual.

From the middle of April, until the end of August tours will run at 9am, 11am with the last ferry leaving the Nelson Mandela Gateway at 1pm.

The peak season commences in September and lasts until the middle of April with tours running at 9am, 11am, 1pm and the last tour at 3pm.

Robben Island Museum is closed for business on May 1- the only public holiday where workers are given off.
